JOINT AND CONCURRENT RESOLUTION

REJECTING THE DEPARTMENT OF ADMINISTRATION'S PROPOSED SALARY INCREASES FOR ELIGIBLE UNCLASSIFIED SERVICE DIRECTORS OF STATE EXECUTIVE DEPARTMENTS

1 WHEREAS, RIGL § 36-4-16.4 requires that in the month of March of each year, the Department of Administration conduct a public hearing to determine salaries to be paid to 2 3 directors of all state executive departments and secretaries serving as the head of any state executive department or executive office; and 4 5 WHEREAS, Said public hearing was held on March 26, 2025; and WHEREAS, RIGL § 36-4-16.4 further requires that upon determination by the 6 7 Department of Administration, the proposed salaries of directors and secretaries will be referred to the General Assembly by the last day of April of that year to go into effect thirty (30) days 8 9 hence, unless rejected by formal action of the House and the Senate acting concurrently within 10 that time: and WHEREAS, By letter dated April 18, 2025 to K. Joseph Shekarchi, Speaker of the House 11 12 of Representatives and Dominick J. Ruggerio, President of the Senate, the Department of 13 Administration did refer eleven (11) such proposed salary increases to the General Assembly; now, therefore be it 14 RESOLVED, That a majority of each House of the General Assembly voting therefor, 15 pursuant to and in accordance with RIGL § 36-4-16.4 hereby REJECT the eleven (11) proposed 16 17 salary increases for eligible unclassified service department directors of state departments as noticed in the letter from the Department of Administration dated April 18, 2025 to the Speaker 18

1 of the House of Representatives and the President of the Senate.
